Wheels cooled off, a non-harmful wheel cleaner is applied one corner at a time and left to soak for around one minute.

The pressure washer is then employed to rinse the brake dust after the first application of wheel cleaner.

Dodo Juice's Captain Crevice Wheel Mitt is then used to access those intricate areas of the wheel. Rob of UF thought it worked a treat! The mitt is really soft so it won't harm a painted surface. Remember to treat wheels as you would paintwork, don't use harsh implements!

This wheel brush was perfect for accessing the deep wheel bolt recesses. The wheel and sidewall of the tyre is then rinsed with the pressure washer.

The bodywork is now subjected to the pressure washer, don't forget those often missed areas such as the fuel filler cap.
